The CESSNA Citation I/ISP, manufactured from 1977-1985, requires a 2 person crew and can transport up to 5 passengers. The aircraft has a maximum operating altitude of 41,000', a normal cruise speed of 345 KTS/397 MPH, and a 887 NM/1,021 SM seats-full range. The unit cost in 1969 was \$695,000; today it is \$4.85M. The Cessna 500 Citation I was powered by two Pratt & Whitney Canada JT15D-1 turbofan engines. These engines, as well as the aircraft's straight wings, make the Citation cruise at significantly slower speeds than other business jets, thus the nickname "Slowtation."
